Science Gallery London is part of an international hub of eight galleries seeking to reinvent the relationships between academia and the community, where Art and Science collide.

The gallery allows artists to work and learn from scientists, and scientists to learn through them. Part of King's College London, the free to visit space targets a key audience of local 15-25-year olds, and is staffed by mediators who study at the University.

The Gallery's home in Grade II\* listed Boland House represents a significant new addition to the cultural landscape of London.

The project programme, incorporating relocation projects, stretched over an 8-year period with construction taking three years, five phases and four different Contractors, all on the live campus. The project delivers many things to the public and to the college but none of these could be described as core curriculum activities for a University, so budgets were tight and had to be deployed carefully. The capital project was generously supported by major funders including Wellcome Trust and Guy's and St Thomas' Charity.

The gallery is free to enter and offers a range of spaces all fully accessible to the general public including a theatre, café and studio spaces.

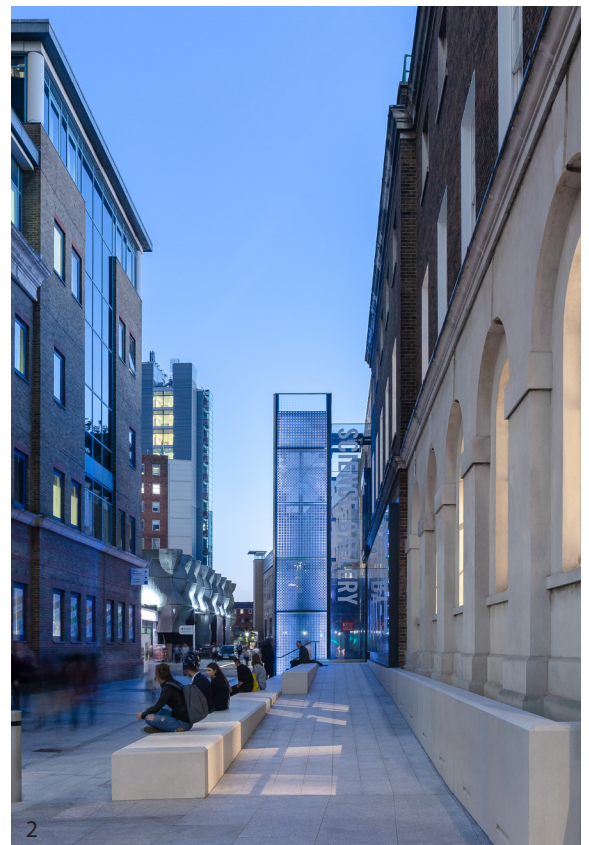
